Dr. Xaverius is an associate professor of epidemiology at Saint Louis University, College for Public Health and Social Justice (SLU-CPHSJ) and director of the MCH-MPH program. She teaches courses in MCH epidemiology, social determinants of health, and the capstone course for MPH epidemiology students. As a MCH Epidemiologist for the state of Missouri and NIH Health Disparity scholar, her work focuses on the health of moms and babies before, during and after pregnancy.

She has been funded by organizations such as the March of Dimes, Robert Wood Johnson Foundation, Missouri Foundation for Health, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, to name a few. She is also published in peer reviewed journals on topics of preconception health, centering pregnancy, and infant mortality, to name a few. As a teacher and researcher, but also mother of three teen-aged daughters, she has a passion for working in the broad area of maternal and child health.
